Terms and Conditions

The following Terms and Conditions must be considered by artist/s wanting to apply for the Griffin Green Region Youth Investment Program Basketball Court artwork Expression of Interest.

The artist/s applying for the Expression of Interest will need to demonstrate significant connections to Wiradjuri Country and the Griffith community.

The artist/s will need to show an ongoing relationship with the Griffith community.

A group of artists may be selected to create the final artwork.

All artist/s involved will understand that they will be part of an ongoing program that is supported by Blank Walls as an educational piece to learn about creating and painting large murals.

The artist/s will need to consider their connections to Wiradjuri country and the Griffith community, and reflect this within the artwork.

Griffith Local Aboriginal Land Council will be assessing all Expressions of Interests and will have the final decision on the choice of artist/s.

Griffith Local Aboriginal Land Council will also work with the artist/s to ensure cultural connections and meaning of Wiradjuri Country and landscape are being expressed within the development of the artwork.

All artist/s will be contacted via email regarding the outcome of the Expression of Interest.

The artist/s will need to be available to work on the program throughout September to November 2023.

Submission

Artist/s applying for the Expression of Interest will need to submit the following:

- Examples of their artworks, along with the meaning behind their work and practice.
- A statement of their strong and significant connection to Wiradjuri Country and the Griffith Community.
- A statement that reflects their reasons of why they would like to be involved with this project.
