What is affordable housing?

Affordable housing provides Australians who are on low to moderate incomes with an opportunity to rent homes at a rate that is below market value rent. These homes are not social housing but affordable private rental homes.

With an average 20% discounted rent, affordable housing provides people with opportunities, whether it works as a temporary shelter or a stepping stone into the private market.

The demand for affordable housing is increasing across Australia, especially for our key workers such as our teachers, healthcare workers, bus drivers, and hospitality workers, who shape and operate our cities.

Who's Eligible?

General criteria

- Be a resident in New South Wales
- Be a citizen or have permanent residency in Australia
- Be able to sustain a successful tenancy, without support or with appropriate support in place
- If applicable, make repayments of any former debts to a social housing provider
- In general, be 18 years of age or older

The eligibility mostly depends on household income, which must be within limits set by the NSW and/or Commonwealth Governments. The more people, including children, living in a household, the higher the household income is allowed to be. The income limit is outlined in the NSW Affordable Housing Guidelines published by NSW Government.
