The weather is starting to get colder, and our client's safety is our upmost priority. Make sure that all gas heater are serviced regularly. If the gas heater is owned by Argyle contact Maintenance. Please don't use gas bottles for cooking inside properties. Fire pits are not to be used in small courtyards with easily flammable items around such as awnings or shade cloth.
