Winter safety in your Home

- Check Electric Blankets before use each year-cords should not be frayed and the blanket covering the wires should not be worn out.
- Don't sleep with the Electric Blanket onwarm the bed and then turn it off.
- Never place heavy items on your bed when the Electric Blanket is turned on.
- Never leave children alone with any open flame.
- Keep it candles away from any combustible material, including curtains, bedding and clothing.
- Heaters should be placed on a flat level surface.
- Never use a gas heater or BVQ made four outdoor use inside your home.
- Always supervise children and pets when heaters are in use.
- Keep heaters well clear from items that might burn. A minimum of one-metre clearance from clothes, bedding, furniture, curtains and other combustibles is recommended.
