Tips for Gas Heater/Gas Bottles/Fire Pit Safety

The weather is starting to get colder, and our client's safety is our upmost priority. Make sure that all gas heater are serviced regularly. If the gas heater is owned by Argyle contact Maintenance. If you own the gas heater, it is tenant's responsibility to get heater serviced. Don't place clothes around gas heaters or any heaters.

Please don't use gas bottles for cooking inside properties. Fire pits are not to be used in small courtyards with easily flammable items around such as awnings or shade cloth.

3G Network for Mobile Phones

The shut down began for TPG/Vodafone network on 15th December 2023. Telstra will shut down on 30th June 2024 and Optus will shut down in September 2024.

If your phone doesn't say "4G LTE" or "5G" in its status bar when Wi-Fi is off, there's a good chance it is a 3G phone and will no longer work after the shut off. Calling 000 will no longer be able to be contacted after shut down.
